Student Drop-Off Procedures (Start of Day)

Who: All middle school studentsWhen: Morning drop-offWhere: The rear of the middle school at Door 6How: Proceed down Falcon Drive and follow the yellow signs directing to the MS student drop off area

Vehicles will form a line in the drop off loop and students will exit the vehicle at the walkway to Door 6

Student Pick-Up Procedures (End of Day)

Who: All middle school students
When: Afternoon pick-up
Where: Only 6th grade students: The rear of the middle school at Door 6
7th and 8th grade students: The side door on the cafeteria patio at Door 5
Any combination of 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students: The side door on the cafeteria patio at Door 5

How: Vehicles will park near their assigned door, and the person picking up a student will walk to the assigned door for dismissal. Students are required to stay inside until an adult comes to the door for pick-up.

Please do not pick your child up at the main entrance during dismissal time.

Winter Sports Physicals and Concussion Testing

Students who are planning to try-out for a winter sport team need to have their PIAA physical packet completed and turned into the main office or the athletic trainers by November 11, 2019. If you had your PIAA physical for a fall sport and are planning on trying out for a winter sport a CIPPE section 7 must be completed by that same date.

If your son or daughter had an injury or illness during the fall after receiving their physical after June 1, 2019, whether at home or school, then section 8 must also be completed. Section 8 must be turned in no later than November 14 if required.

The breakfast concert is Thursday, December 5, beginning at 8:00 am, at the middle school cafetorium. Doors to the CCMS cafetorium at the rear of the building will open at 7:30 am. Tickets are required.
