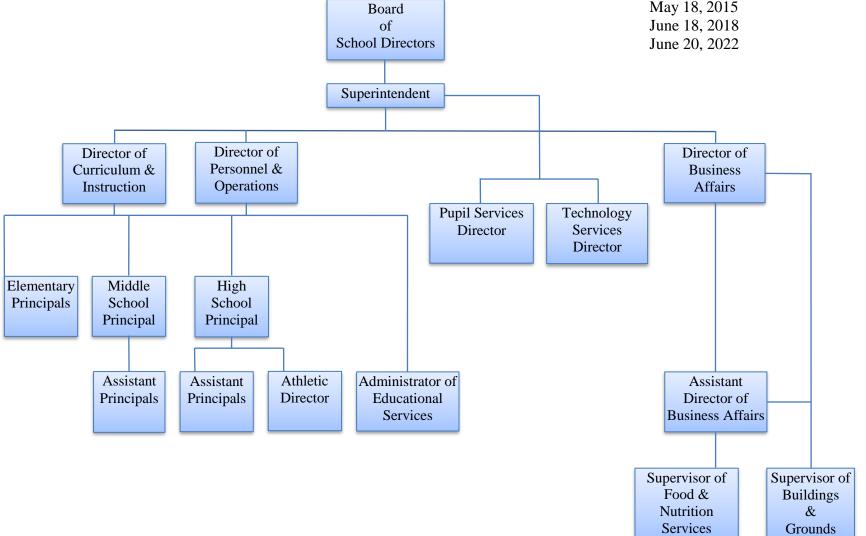

Purpose

The Board recognizes the need to implement the required accounting and financial reporting standards stipulated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

GASB (Governmental Accounting Standards Board) Statement 34 requires the district to implement full accrual, liability and asset financial statement reporting requirements and establish capital asset tracking and accounting as a result of those requirements.

The primary objectives of implementing the GASB Statement 34 are to assure compliance with state requirements, and properly account for both the financial and economic resources of the district. In conjunction with GASB 34 requirements, this policy will document the district's Capital Asset guidelines.

Definitions

This policy governs the district's acquisition and depreciation of capital assets. Capital assets include land and land improvements, site improvements, buildings and building additions, building improvements, furniture, fixtures and equipment, equipment under lease, vehicles, works of art and historical treasures, construction-in-progress, and infrastructure. **Capital assets** are tangible assets used in operations that do not change their shape, appearance, or character with use and have initial useful lives extending beyond one (1) year with reasonable care and maintenance.

Infrastructure is defined as long-lived capital assets that are stationary in nature and can normally be preserved for a significantly greater number of years than most capital assets. Infrastructure includes roads, electrical distribution systems, networking equipment, street lighting, water wells, etc. Infrastructure assets shall be depreciated over their useful lives. Routine repairs and maintenance costs are charged to operations as incurred. Expenditures that extend the useful life of the infrastructure are capitalized as part of the asset and depreciated over the newly established

useful life.

Authority

Participation of the school district in any such activity shall be in accordance with Board policy.[1][2]

Delegation of Responsibility

The responsibility to coordinate the compilation and preparation of all information necessary to implement this policy is delegated to the Director of Business Affairs.

The Director of Business Affairs shall prepare the required Management Discussion and Analysis (MD&A). The MD&A shall be in the form required by GASB Statement 34. The district's local independent auditor shall review the MD&A, in accordance with SAS No. 52, "Required Supplementary Information." Final version of the MD&A will be submitted to the Board for approval as a part of the annual Audit Report.

The Director of Business Affairs shall be responsible for implementing the necessary procedures to establish and maintain a capital asset inventory, including depreciation schedules. Depreciation shall be computed on a straight-line basis over the useful lives of the assets, using an averaging convention.

Guidelines

Capital Assets

Any asset that has been acquired with debt proceeds or capital reserve funds shall be capitalized, regardless of the cost of the asset.

Otherwise, capital asset purchases must exceed \$5,000 per item (determined by the original/historical acquisition cost or value) to be classified on the capital asset records of the district. These costs include the charges of preparing or installing the asset for use. Ancillary charges such as freight and professional fees shall also be considered as part of the acquisition cost.

Items having an acquisition purchase cost of less than \$5,000 per item will be considered capital assets if they are part of a "lot" purchase where the total purchase amount exceeds \$100,000 and the items have a useful life exceeding one (1) year. The typical example of this type of asset is technology equipment. The Director of Business Affairs may capitalize assets falling below the "lot" threshold, as appropriate.

The Director of Business Affairs should periodically review these dollar threshold levels with assistance from the local independent auditor. The Director of Business Affairs is authorized to make any necessary modifications to both the "per item" and "lot" threshold levels to remain compliant with GASB 34.

Capital assets shall be depreciated over their useful lives as determined for each asset class. Depreciation is calculated on all capital assets reported in the district financial statements other than land, land improvements, and construction-in-progress.

Donations: Capital assets, as defined above, that are obtained through charitable means shall be approved by the Board of Directors and reported at fair market value as of the date of the donation. Such assets are depreciated over their useful lives in the same fashion as other capital assets.

Collections: Works of art, historical treasures and similar assets shall be capitalized if their acquisition cost or fair market value at the date of donation equals or exceeds the capitalization threshold. Items or collections that are exhaustible shall be depreciated over their useful lives. Depreciation is not necessary if the items or collections are considered to be inexhaustible.

<u>Disposals</u>

When capital assets are sold or disposed, a gain or loss transaction is recorded and the asset values are removed from the district's records. The calculation is based upon the amount of proceeds received less the net book value (cost less accumulated depreciation) at the date of sale or disposal.

Assets Acquired by Capital Lease

Assets acquired by capital lease agreements are recorded at the net present value of the future minimum lease payments. A corresponding liability is established at the same time. Assets acquired under the terms of capital leases are depreciated over the useful life for that asset class.
